

Soap Bottle Cover

Have some fun while washing the dishes and dress up your kitchen sink with this cute cover-up for your dish soap bottle.

Skill Level: Beginner

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Required Software:

Amazing Designs Embroidery CD - ADC-102J Italian Kitchen
Amazing Designs Edit Express (included with design collection)
Designs used: ITALIA118 and ITALIA114

Supplies:

- Machine embroidery needles
- Jumbo Hoop (130 x 180 minimum size)
- Madeira 40 wt Rayon machine embroidery thread
- Heavy Cut-Away stabilizer: 13" x 13" piece to fit the complete bottle apron
- 5" x 7" piece of light tear-away stabilizer to float under the hoop
- Stabilize It! Water Soluble Topping: ADS-3036L
- Plain Kitchen towel
- Embroidery adhesive spray
- 1 hook and loop dot

Read through all instructions before beginning.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Bottle Apron:

1. Enlarge the bottle cover pattern 200%.
2. Cut the apron pattern out.
3. Fold the kitchen towel in half. Lay the apron pattern on fold of the kitchen towel and pin in place.
4. Cut the apron out of the kitchen towel.

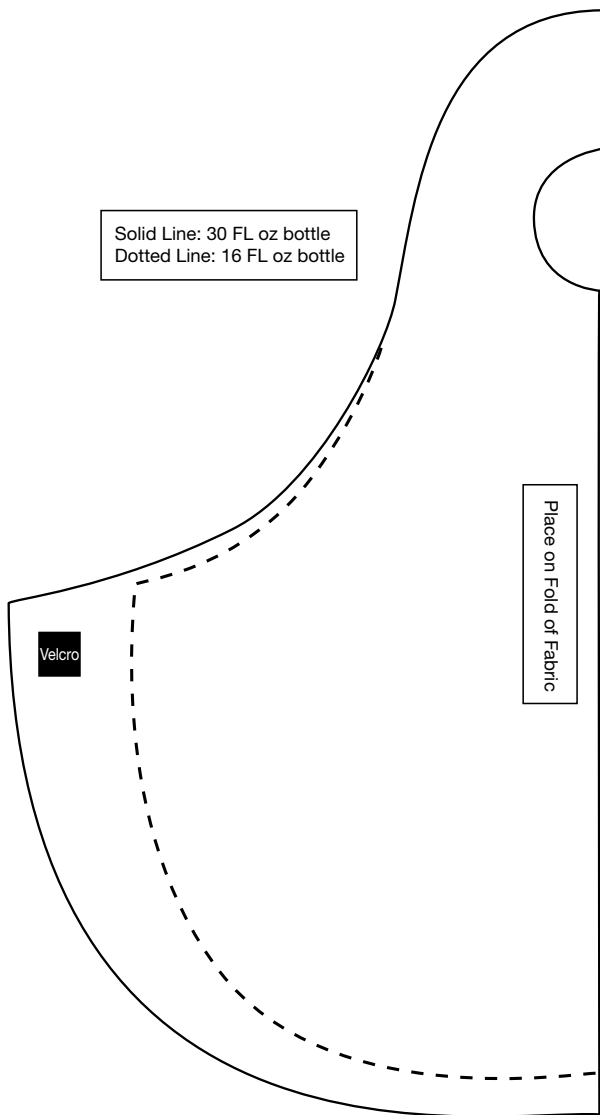
Embroidery and Construction:

1. Open Edit Express software.
2. Click on File/Browse and find the Italian Kitchen collection on the CD.
3. Select design ITALIA118 and print out a template. Select design ITALIA114 and print out a template.
4. Cut out the templates and place them on the bottle apron fabric. Pin in place.
5. Hoop the heavy cut-away stabilizer; make sure the hoop is in the center of the stabilizer.
6. Spray the hooped stabilizer with the embroidery adhesive.
7. Center the apron and templates in the embroidery hoop and press the fabric in place onto the stabilizer.



Embroidery and Construction (continued):

8. Lightly spray the water soluble topping with the Embroidery adhesive.
9. Place the topping on top of the embroidery area of the bottle apron. Slide the tear away stabilizer under the hoop.
10. Embroider the two designs onto the bottle apron.
11. Remove the bottle apron from the embroidery hoop and remove the tear-away stabilizer.
12. Trim the cut-away stabilizer to fit the bottle apron.
13. With a satin stitch setting on your sewing machine, satin stitch around the raw edges of the bottle cover and stabilizer.
(settings: zig-zag width: 4.5 stitch length: 4.0)
14. Stitch the Velcro to the bottle apron. (see pattern for location of Velcro)
